Gear Up

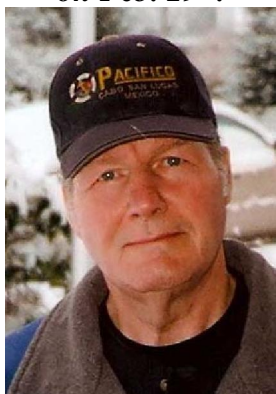

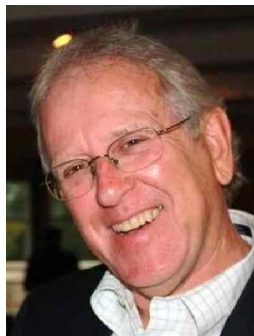

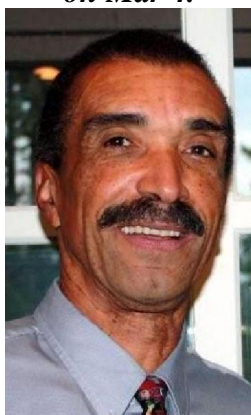
